

Centered in beautiful Timber Linn Park, located just off of Interstate 5, the Festival features approximately 70 booths showcasing arts and crafts from a variety of media. Activities have been planned throughout the two day event to draw participants to the area, while still featuring the art and craft show. They include:

- Friday evening's Night Glow hot air balloon display will light up the sky and delight visitors who have come to watch and stay to shop.
- A free Saturday evening concert featuring a well-known artist will take place as visitors relax on the grassy slopes of the adjacent outdoor amphitheater. In the past, performers have included Joan Jett, Styx, Foreigner, Los Lobos, Little River Band, and Creedence Clearwater Revisted, generating crowds of up to 17,000 people.
- Hands-on activities for children.
- Performances on the festival stage throughout the 2 days will create an atmosphere of fun and frivolity.
- Food booths and micro beer & wine tasting will be featured.
- Early morning hot air balloon lift-offs. (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday)
- Car Show
- Airport Activities (Saturday and Sunday)

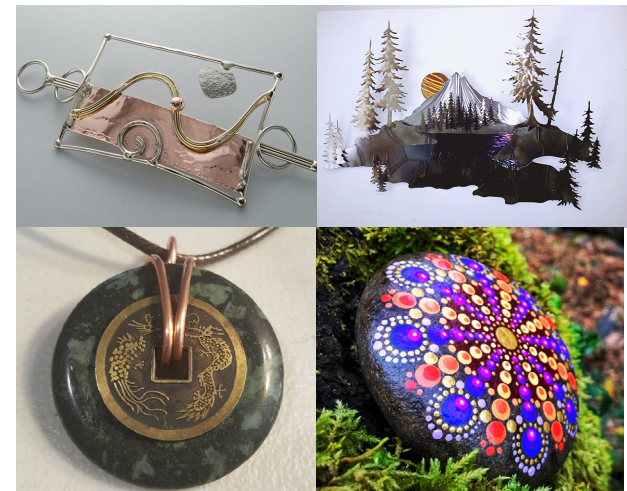

CRITERIA

- The Festival is open to all artists. All artists must use a separate entry form for each category entered.
- All work must be for sale.
- All work must be original by the artist submitting the application.
- Artists may not display the work of another non-joined artist. Two artists may share booth space if both have been joined into the show. Booth fee is \$80 each.
- Artists may apply in more than one category but must submit a separate application form and 5 images for each medium. Artists will not be allowed to display work in categories for which they were not accepted.

APPLICATION FEE

This festival does not charge an application fee. We will not share your contact information unless authorized by you to do so.

BOOTH FEE

After notification of acceptance, booth space assignments are made upon receipt of the \$140 booth fee. Because one of the purposes of this Festival is to promote art in Albany, booth fees remain low and a commission fee will not be collected. Electricity is available at no additional charge. Artists are encouraged to bring lights for their booth.

PROMOTION

A major promotional effort utilizing print, radio, television, artists postcards, and posters will help attract a diverse and widespread audience to the Festival.

SECURITY

Artists are responsible for security of their work at all times. A staff member is available on the grounds 24-hours per day from Thursday noon through Sunday at 8 a.m. The Festival is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft.

EXHIBIT & BOOTH INFORMATION

Exhibit spaces are 10' x 10'. Artists are responsible for providing all equipment (**including canopy**), staffing, assembling, and dismantling of their booths/displays. Artists are responsible for the security of their belongings at all times. All display, booth material, and artwork must be confined to the designated booth space. Artist should come prepared for inclement weather. Booth/Display must have Festival approval. In order to obtain preapproval, **a photo should be included with your application that shows your booth/display area.**

Artist is strongly encouraged to bring lighting for their booth. Artists should come prepared to sell until 8 p.m. on both Friday and Saturday night. The Friday Night Glow and the Saturday evening concert generate large crowds during the evening. Artists are welcome to stay open later than 8 p.m. and may find that doing so increases sales.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Completed and signed application form.
- A minimum of five (5) photos. High-resolution digital images are preferred. Slides (labeled with the name of the artist) may be accepted in cases where digital images are not available.

CHECK-IN/LOAD-IN

Artists will be able to drive on-site on Friday, August 23rd beginning at 8 a.m. for unloading and set-up until 10 a.m. **All vehicles will be prohibited in the vendor area from 10:30 a.m. Friday until Sunday at 8 a.m.** Artists should come prepared to move items using a handtruck or other devices. You will need to be open for business by 11 a.m. when the festival opens.

We encourage artists to set-up on Thursday (9 a.m.- 5 p.m.). If you are a returning artist and would like to set-up Thursday evening that can be done with approval.

To be more accommodating to what our guests have indicated they would like we are going to a two-day festival. We will now be open at 11am on Friday and all day on Saturday and not on Sunday. This will give us the ability to offer more fun for the entire family all day on Friday! We will continue to launch Hot Air Balloons on Sunday morning, but we will no longer have the festival event site open that day. We have historically had very low attendance on Sunday and it does not make financial sense to ask our food and art vendors to participate on a day that we don't get a lot of guests. With this change we will be looking to add some fun new elements, change some things that need updating and overall just make this amazing event even better!
